GRANTS AND DONATIONS TO SCHOOLS

Per SDCL (South Dakota Codified Law) 13-14-5: Every school district in this state is empowered to accept, own, manage, and dispose of any grant, gift, devise, or bequest of money, or real or personal property; and the school board of such school district shall have power to enter into such agreement for the receipt thereof upon such terms as shall be the best interest of all parties and to make such rules and regulations as it may deem best for the ownership, management, and control of such property.

The West Central School District recognizes that, periodically, certain grants from public and private sources become available to help support specific programs and operations of the school district. While grant funding sources may be a valuable supplement to the school district and its educational programs, grant proposals may require monetary or in-kind contribution by the school district.

Prior to submitting an application for any new grant funds, the grant writer shall complete a written request to the superintendent/business office. The superintendent will approve or deny all requests.
