

ADMISSION OF NONRESIDENT STUDENTS/
ASSIGNMENT OF RESIDENT STUDENTS

The West Central School District will accept students from other districts, who wish to enroll, provided the West Central School District can provide a quality educational program for the applicant student based upon factors/criteria/standards adopted by the board (see Section B. in JECB-R) and subject to the following general principles outlined in regulation.

(For the purposes of this policy, the term “resident district” means the district in which a student has legal residence as determined by SDCL 13-28-9. The term “nonresident district” means the school district in which a nonresident student seeks to enroll. An “emancipated student” is a student under the age of 18 who (1) has entered into a valid marriage, (2) is on active military duty, or (3) who has obtained a court order declaring the child emancipated.)

A student who is a legal resident of another South Dakota district seeking to transfer into the West Central School District must apply to the West Central School District and the resident district.
